Meeting Forgotten Health Needs:

Please pray for people with chronic illnesses

While we give a lot of attention to the emergency needs of refugees, it is also important to think about longer-term issues.

Refugees with existing health conditions, quickly run out of medication once they have fled home, with potentially disastrous consequences. At the Karegheusan Medical Centre in Beirut, refugees from Syria and local people living in poverty can get treatment for chronic conditions such as diabetes, high blood pressure, epilepsy and cancer. Many of the patients have slipped through the net of other aid agencies or are not eligible for government support, so the clinic is vital to their quality of life.

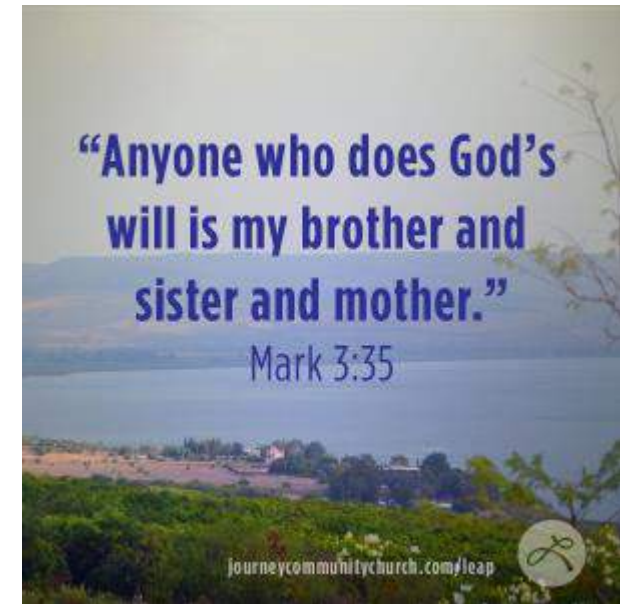
