But life is far from easy in Cairo, and our partner Refuge Egypt make it their mission to give practical and emotional support to people far from home. As well as offering emergency help, Refuge Egypt aims to build refugees' resilience in the longer term. Their training courses teach refugees the necessary skills to enter Egypt's workforce, and the jobs service puts them in contact with employers.
