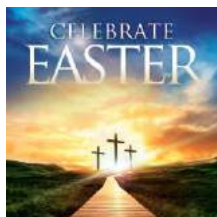

'Reflections on the Last Seven Words of Jesus'.



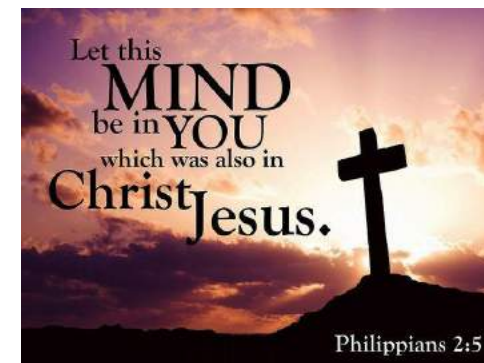
